What NOT to Bring	What to Bring

Alcohol, alcohol containers, or paraphernalia	Academic supplies
Fireworks or explosives	Alarm clock
Extension cords and multiple socket plugs	Bedding and clothing
LED strip lights with adhesive backing	Bicycles (must be stored in designated spaces)
Halogen lamps, lamps with an open cover, and spider lamps	Command strips for decorating
Illegal drugs or paraphernalia	Computer, laptop, or tablet
Mopeds and hoverboards	Laundry & cleaning supplies
Nails or tacks	Only university-issued electric heaters are allowed
Plug-in scents	Shower curtain
Personal heaters	Surge protectors with a circuit breaker, on/off switch, and reset button
Tobacco products	Toiletries
Weapons, including airsoft, BB, paintball guns, swords, knives	Trash can

Remember – you’ll be here for 6 weeks, and then return for fall. All of your décor, etc., is not needed at this time.
