Whether you're planning a performance for the entire campus or just for your organization, this form allows you to reserve the space before everyone else on campus is able to reserve space. Recurring meetings will be submitted through 25Live on Nov. 15.

Requests for Phase One of Priority Scheduling are handled via appointments with any member of the organization listed and verified on the Garnet Gate roster. Student Organizations may participate up to two (2) times during Phase One, and appointment scheduling is determined by a randomization process to ensure fairness of access for all organizations for round one, and then again for round two. Spaces that are available for scheduling in Phase One are the Russell House Ballroom, Russell House Theater, Russell Underground, Greene Street, Russell House Patio, Davis Fields, Rutledge Chapel and the Gressette Room.
