The University of South Carolina Beaufort's 100% online Bachelor of Science in Public Health prepares students for the multidisciplinary field of practice concerned with designing, implementing, and evaluating interventions that enable individuals, families, groups, organizations, and communities to play active roles in achieving, protecting, and sustaining the public's health.

More interdisciplinary, with a broader liberal arts focus and emphasis on policy and community engagement. Ideal for those interested in roles involving community outreach, policy development, or education. Our public health program aligns with the National Commission for Health Education Credentialing's seven areas of responsibility, equipping students for advanced studies in natural and environmental public health sciences, as well as entry-level positions in the field.

Curriculum

The curriculum includes coursework in the following disciplines:

- **Health Promotion and Education** - 21 credit hours
- **Epidemiology** - 3 credit hours
- **Research and Field Experience** - 6 credit hours
- **Internship & Evaluation** - 7 credit hours
- **Leadership and Management** - 3 credit hours
- **Program Development & Evaluation** - 6 credit hours

Prerequisites and Requirements

To apply for this online degree program, students must have a preferred 2.0 cumulative GPA in all previous college-level coursework. In addition to 45-60 credit hours from a regionally accredited institution, students transferring to the program are encouraged to review the list of completed coursework needed for eligibility on the program's webpage.
